Jim Braun will continue to serve as the AVANTech's President and Chuck Jensen will serve as Executive Vice-President.

President Jim Braun remarked, "This transaction between industry leaders doubles AVANTech's capacity and provides us with key operations personnel and products needed to provide full services to the utility radioactive waste market. This rounds out our complete offering".

"Both AVANTech and DTS were leaders in their areas and now they complement each other in one organization to make us the full service answer to nuclear industry needs."
